Grape variety: Merlot 80%, Teran 20%
Category: dry rose wine
Wine-growing area: West Istria, Croatia
Vineyard: Vale and Santa Lucia
Vineyard age: 12 – 21 years
Altitude of vineyard: 200 – 240 m
Vineyard orientation: south
Soil composition: flysch, limestone, clay
Harvested: by hand
Vinification: manual selection of grapes, cryo maceration 4 – 5 h, pressing, fermentation

Tasting note

Violetta 2019 displays a medium deep salmon colour. Wine is medium intense on the nose with youthful and bright cherry, raspberry and grapefruit, combined with some fresh apples and lemons at the back. In a word, loads of playful freshness in the bottle! Dry on the palate, medium bodied, with moderate acidities. Good fruit persistence and true follower of the aromas on the nose, with addition of some extra layers on the palate. Being in between a cheerful rose and a straightforward wine, Violetta may be enjoyed for both occasional pleasure but also in a serious wine and food pairing.

Food matching

Violetta is a good companion for an entire summer meal, but served as an aperitif it promise a lots of pleasure. Dare to serve it with most of the summer main dishes. In one word, a great summer wine.

Aging potential

Best to enjoy during 2020-2021 but will remain lovely during 2-3 years more.
