Grape variety: Merlot 80%, Teran 20%
Category: dry rose wines
Wine-growing area: West Istria, Croatia
Vineyard: Vale and Santa Lucia
Vineyard age: 13 – 22 years
Altitude of vineyard: 200 – 240 m
Vineyard orientation: south
Soil composition: flysch, limestone, clay
Harvested: by hand

Tasting note

Violetta 2020 is dressed in a very modern pale pink dress. Very fresh and youthful on the nose, with immediate reminiscence of crushed red fruits - raspberries and strawberries being the obvious associations. Very inviting indeed.

Dry on the palate, medium bodied, with moderate acidities. In the same fashion as on the nose crushed berries are reappearing on the palate offering a nice consistency through all the phases of the tasting/drinking experience. Light to medium bodied with moderate acidities and refreshing, youthful feel on the palate. One can hardly imagine a better drink on a hot summer day. Very drinkable!

Food matching

Violetta is an all-rounder that can be well served as an aperitif but will give lots of pleasure all the way through the meal. It will even work as a steward with most of the first courses and even some main dishes. Perfect summer wine.

Aging potential

This is best to be drunk young - from 2021-2022 but will keep well for at least two years.
