

VIOLETTA 2021



Grape variety: Merlot 80%, Teran 20%
Category: dry rose wines
Wine-growing area: West Istria, Croatia
Vineyard: Vale and Santa Lucia
Vineyard age: 14 – 23 years
Altitude of vineyard: 200 – 240 m
Vineyard orientation: south
Soil composition: flysch, limestone, clay
Harvested: by hand
Vinification: manual selection of grapes, cryo maceration 5 – 6 h, pressing, fermentation
Aging: inox

Tasting note

Violetta 2021 displays a modern pale pink dress with some orange tinges. Youthful on the nose, showing freshly crushed berry fruit such as strawberry, raspberries, blackberry, and cherries. There is a touch of rosehip and a hint of some very ripe even dried black fruits. All in all, a rose with true Mediterranean origin!

It is very dry on the palate, medium to full bodied, with moderate acidities. The character on the palate reminds of the aroma profile on the nose, though a bit less intense. Nicely balanced and long, with fine saltiness. Very tasty! Violetta 2021 is a great aperitif, but not only that. It is a proper food wine as well. Nicely drinkable with a medium long to long finish.

Food matching

Though it functions as a great aperitif and a perfect summer wine by glass, we should think of Violetta is very good food companion. Serve it with the seafood, or fish carpaccio with olive oil. The bravest would add capers. A perfect match!

Aging potential

Best to be drunk young - from 2022-2023 but will keep well for at least two years.
